SiteNum	Site_Name	Directions
1	0.1	Mapped start point is at the intersection of James Ave. and Flanagan/Horseshoe. Drive about 30 yards south from intersection with James and stop at deep ditch and grassed waterway on right (west) side of road.
2	0.8	Continue south on James Rd. Stop at bridge over mid-sized stream.
3	1.3	Continue south stop is just past a house at a low point in road. Very small creek passes under road bordered by trees, reed canary, etc Crop on right side of road, pasture on left side of road.
4	2.2	Continue south, cross over 52. Start down big hill and just before 55 mph curve sign ther is a pond in the hollow on the left. There is a field pull in on the right. Pond is by farm house and long drive way.
5	2.8	Continue south on James. Follow hill down and around curve - on left in pasture is a good sized streams with wet spots in pasture. Be careful here -there is not a good pull off and road is curvy.
6	5.1	At stop sign take a left onto Hannan Rd. Stop at bridge.
7	6.5	Follow Hannan Rd. to the left. PAss cattle yard and on up the hill. Stop at guard rail/fence on right. Marshy grassy area in hollow of pasture below this guard rail. Field pull in to the left.
8	9.2	Left on springdale and then left on Asbury. Large low ditch area filled with cattails on left side of road. Field pull in on left just beyond it.
9	10.3	Continue on Asbury and go around 2-3 big curves. Just before 35 MPH curve road sign is a creek - tree lined on right side, bordered by pasture/cropfield on left. Couple of field pull ins here. Cattails in left ditch.
10	11.7	Take a right on Five Points/Graf Rd. at 4 way intersection. Stop at intersection with Potter Hill Rd. Heritage Trail and tree lined creek 25 yards east of intersection.
