





Site Number	Name	County	Latitude	Longitude	Directions
1	0.8	Shelby	41.591301	-95.3833008	Drive north from intersection of F58 and Ironwood or 0.8 miles. Grassed waterway on left side of road.
2	1.5	Shelby	41.6001015	-95.3832016	Drive north on Ironwood. Stop at small narrow grassed creek running under road.
3	2.1	Shelby	41.6092987	-95.3833008	Continue north on Ironwood. Stop at intersection with 750th by narrow bridge.
4	3	Shelby	41.6227989	-95.3835983	Continue north on Ironwood. Stop just before next intersection at the creek that passes under the road.
5	4.2	Shelby	41.6394997	-95.3839035	Continue north on Ironwood. Stop at grassed waterway on right side of road through crop field.
6	8	Shelby	41.6787987	-95.4023972	Turn left on 44 then north on Hazel. Stop at wooden planked bridge.
7	9	Shelby	41.6889	-95.4082031	Continue north on Hazel then turn left on 1300th. Stop shortly at grassed waterway on the left.
8	9.5	Shelby	41.6890984	-95.4179993	Continue west on 1300th. Stop at bridge.
9	11.1	Shelby	41.7104988	-95.4215012	Turn rigt on M16. Stop at field pull off just beyond narrow creek running under bridge.
10	12.7	Shelby	41.7182007	-95.4026031	Turn right (east) on F32. Stop just before entering Westphalia - deep ditch with cattails on both sides. Field pull off on left in front of cement block shed.
