### **Backbone State Park\***

9:00 AM

Meeting Location: Old Shop just east of the East Gate park entrance

**Description:** Join a 1 to 1.5-mile hike from the office area down the Bluebird Trail to the east gate and walk down the road to the Backbone Trail. If there is no snow or ice the group will venture down the trail for the breathtaking views and amazing rock formations that Backbone is known for. If the trail is deemed too slick, we will stick to the road.

The trail has some parts paved changing to dirt and grass. The Backbone Trail is rugged and rocky.

# **Big Creek State Park**

**SELF GUIDED HIKE** 

Trailhead Location: Beach Parking Lot

**Description:** Enjoy a 5-mile out and back (turn around at any point on the path) hike. Start at the beach parking lot and head southeast along the Neal Smith Trail to the Big Creek Dam, then turn around and head back. The full length of the trail is 2.5 miles one way; it is paved and fairly flat. Enjoy the views of the park and lake, along with the chance to see various wildlife species along the trail. Please dress for the weather and be sure to drink plenty of water.

Trailhead and turn-around will be signed.

**Description:** Hike the .5-mile Bird Observation Blind Trail - start behind the George Wyth Lodge. Take a pit stop at the Audubon Bird Blind. Continue down the trail and turn right at the trail intersection. Northern Saw-whet Owls often frequent this area in late fall and winter; look in cedar trees where branches meet the trunk. Just before the trail opens up into the picnic area, take a right to get onto the Lodge Trail to make a loop. The trail is a dirt path. Dress for

The crushed rock trail is mostly flat, with a steep section from the lodge to the trailhead, and then at the dam.

**Description:** Enjoy this self-guided out-and-back South Trail Hike, which is about 1.5 miles.
