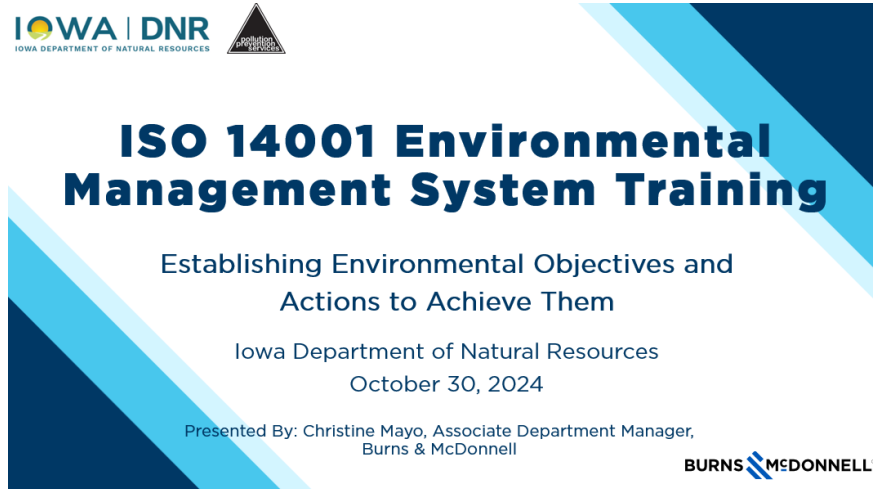


Join us for the 2nd session of the Pollution Prevention Services ISO 14001 Environmental Management System Interactive Webinar Series
