**These instructions begin after a license has already been purchased*

ATTENTION: Only fill out the Harvest Information Program (HIP) Survey if you have already purchased or intend to purchase your Migratory Bird Fee/Permit or intend to hunt doves.

HIP is required to hunt migratory game birds which include: dove, ducks, geese, coots, woodcock, rails, and snipe.

Harvest Information Program (HIP)

- Print certain privilege(s) at home immediately (e.g. fishing, small game hunting, fur harvesting, & licenses). You will also receive a confirmation email after your transaction with an electronic PDF copy of your eligible license(s). Physical tags are required for certain hunting licenses. Be sure to add your email address to your customer profile to enjoy this benefit.

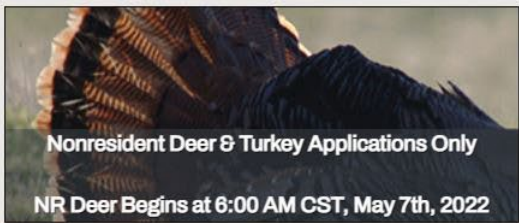
