Typically, we schedule these for delivery first thing in the AM. We require that ALL deliveries of dead animals/carcasses be declared to the scale. We reserve the right to reject any load that is not accurately declared. We require that generators of dead animals deliver them to the landfill. We do not allow dead animals to be placed in convenience containers. As with any unusual waste stream, advanced notification is greatly appreciated.	No	We identify diseased carcasses as a special waste, and thus require a special waste profile be completed, and written pre-approval be requested. We impose specific delivery requirements for diseased carcasses. Protocols for pathogen stabilization (i.e. application of lime; macroencapsulation, etc.) may also be required.
