A license is required for anyone performing taxidermy commercially. All specimens must be lawfully acquired, within season, and under proper license. All specimens must be tagged with the owner's name, address, and date of kill. A federal taxidermy license is also required if migratory birds are to be mounted. By signing below, I acknowledge and understand the rules and regulations regarding having this permit and realize that all transactions, tags, and specimens left in the custody of a taxidermist by another person shall be open to inspection by a conservation officer at any reasonable time. The lowa laws can be found in lowa Code Chapter 481A and the residency laws in lowa Code Chapter 483A and lowa Administrative Code Chapter 15.
