The 2022 Stream & Watershed Integrated Management (SWIM) Workshop will be held July 11-13, 2022 at Whiterock Conservancy Bur Oak Visitor Center in Coon Rapids, IA. The registration fee for the workshop is \$115.00. This fee covers materials, three lunches and two dinners. The workshop will start at 9am Monday, July 11 and conclude at 3pm on Wednesday, July 13. Lodging is not provided for participants, however lodging is available in the nearby towns of Jefferson and Carroll or at Whiterock Conservancy.

The workshop will include indoor classroom sessions along with field experiences on two days of the workshop. These activities are planned in and around streams. Clothing and footwear that can get wet and muddy are a must. Rubber boots or hip waders are recommended, but old tennis shoes will work as well. It is also recommended that you bring a hat, sunscreen, bug spray, rain gear, and water bottle. Due to the need to carpool to field sites we are asking participants that are able to provide a higher capacity vehicle to do so.
