

Chuck “Coach” Hallier Memorial Scholarship Application

Purpose

The Hallier family and the Iowa Archery in the Schools Program are supporting a High School Senior Scholarship program. The program is to honor the memory of Chuck Hallier for his dedication to the archery program. He was mentor to archers and coaches in the teaching of archery and instilled lifelong skills that include self-respect and respect to others.

Award Component

Two Senior scholarship recipient will be selected and each awarded a \$1,000 scholarship.

Award Criteria

1. Applicant must be in Iowa Archery in the Schools Program and participate in the competitive league program for their senior year in high school plus one additional year while in high school.
2. Applicant must demonstrate plans to attend an institution of higher learning, which may be a 2-year or a 4-year college or vocational school.
3. Applicant must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
4. Applicant must be in good standing with their archery club/program.

Application Process

1. Each student must type out their own application on the provided form
2. A copy of their most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
3. A letter from the student’s head coach confirming high school years participating in the archery program, along with confirmation of being in good standing with the club/program, with a signature from the coach. **This must be submitted separately by the coach.**
4. A typed essay 300 words max.

The scholarship award will be presented to the recipients during Iowa NASP State Tournament Award Ceremony in Des Moines.
