



Application for an Operation Permit for Emergency Land Application of Wastewater
567 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 64.3 and Iowa Code Section 455B.174

Why this is Required?

This form may be used to apply for a one-time, emergency land application permit. An emergency is defined as a sudden or unexpected condition which is beyond the reasonable control of the facility in response to which land application of wastewater is necessary within 30 days to prevent damage to property, risk to human health, or the uncontrolled release of wastewater from a storage structure. Examples would include, but are not limited to a natural disaster which renders a permitted application site unusable as planned, damage to a wastewater storage structure which is not due to the negligence or an intentional act of the owner of the storage structure, and extreme precipitation events which are determined at the sole discretion of the Department to not be reasonably anticipatable. An emergency does not include a failure to obtain permit approval in a timely manner, the failure to properly inspect and maintain storage structure, or other conditions within the control of the facility.
