If not all the manure is to be sold, you must comply with 567 IAC 65.111(2) for the portion of the manure not being sold. Use one form per operation. Please complete the entire form, sign it, date it and mail as indicated on page 2.

Operations with 500 animal units or less, or those constructed prior to May 31, 1985 and that have not expanded, are not required to file this manure management plan.

a. Confinement feeding operations applying for a construction permit must submit this manure management plan form and all the required construction application documents (Form 542-1428) and fees to the Iowa DNR at the address below. One copy of all paperwork (not including fee payment) should also be submitted to the county.

b. Confinement feeding operations with more than 500 AU that do not need a construction permit or that are submitting an annual manure management plan update, must submit this manure management plan form and the completed Fee Form (542-4021) and mail it with your check (payable to Iowa DNR) to your nearest Field Office (www.lowaDNR.gov/FieldOffice). One copy of all paperwork (not including fee payment) should also be submitted to the county.

The information within this form, and supporting documents describes that the dry manure produced at my (our) confinement feeding operation is or will be sold under lowa Code chapter 200 or 200A. I (we) will manage the dry manure, and the nutrients it contains, as required in Iowa Code chapter 200 or 200A. Transport of my (our) dry manure off site, will be done in a manner that will minimize surface or ground water pollution. Deviations permitted by Iowa law will be documented and maintained in my records.
